



Bike tracks to the Gungahlin Site

Suggested route to avoid crossing the Barton Highway at Bellenden St.

Coming from the city there are two ways to get on the bike path that passes under the Barton Highway just outside of Kaleen.

- 1) Following Mouat St. which becomes Ellenborough Rd. you continue past the most northerly entrance to Cossington Smith Cr. and take the next right where the bike path divides (going left will take you up a hill towards Kaleen). The right path shortly comes to a crossing over Ellenborough Rd. Cross the road and remain on the bike path as it goes under and along the eastern side of the highway. The same path will head up Gunghalin Dr to a set of lights where you cross to get to CSE.
- 2) **Coming from Northbourne Ave.** you will find a dedicated bike path on both sides of the road but stay on the left so that you can turn onto the Barton highway. Continue until you reach the exit to Lyneham (Ellenborough Rd.) but go past the exit and look for the footpath/bikepath entrance immediately on your left (watch out for traffic entering the highway also on your left) then continue as in (1)
- 3) **Coming from Belconnen suburbs** the crossing is opposite the entrance to Bellenden St. This requires great care to cross the road as there are no traffic lights to stop traffic. However the viewing distance is considerable both ways. Take your time and cross safely.
